
Removing iPads from the cart

- Make sure your hands are clean!
- Unplug Carefully
- Pull out of slot
- Hold iPad with both hands
- Sit iPad on table BEFORE pulling out chair
- Sit in chair
- Keep your hands in your lap and off the iPad while you wait for teacher instructions



Basic Operation

- Portrait and Landscape
- Home Button and slide the slider bar
- Swipe fingers to change pages (dots at the bottom represent pages)
- Explain how home button works
- Explain search
- Explain folders



YOU are responsible for the iPad you checked out!

Do's

- When carrying the iPad, use two hands
- Ask for help if you're not sure about something
- Visit apps that the teacher tells you to visit
- Only 1 person "pilots" the iPad at a time.
- Touch the screen gently

YOU are responsible for the iPad you checked out! Don'ts

- Delete apps or work
- Grab the iPad from someone
- Eat or Drink around iPads
- Use the camera unless a teacher tells you to
- change wallpaper or folders
- lock the iPad with a passcode
- search for inappropriate sites or create inappropriate material
- Download or delete apps

Rules to Remember!

DO NOT use the camera unless a teacher tells you to

Use the app the teacher assigned

DO NOT change wallpaper or folders

DO NOT lock the iPad with a passcode

DO NOT search for inappropriate sites or create inappropriate material

DO NOT download or delete apps

Basic Care

- •Use a soft cloth to wipe the iPad clean
- •Keep the iPad out of extreme heat or cold
- •Wash your hands before use!

- Choose and type 3 expectations for iPad use on the notepad app.
- Take pictures of your group members displaying the appropriate behavior.
- 3. Upload pictures to the "Pic Collage" App.

iPad Rules

Be Safe

Keep the iPad on a flat surface.
-Remain seated

Be Responsible

-Use the appropriate apps -Have clean hands: -Speak with the teacher if you have a problem.

Be Respectful

-Monitor your time limit.

-Wipe off your fingerprints with a soft cloth.

-Let your teacher know when the battery is less than 50%.
